1. Abraham Lincoln

Elected president in 1860

Leader of the Union (U.S.A.) during the Civil War

Against Slavery

Primary focus after southern states secede = “preserve the Union”

2. Jefferson Davis

Elected as president of the Confederate States

3. Ulysses S. Grant

Appointed as the general in command of the Union Army during the Civil War

4. William Tecumseh Sherman

Second in command of the Union Army during the Civil War

Famous for his “March to the Sea” in which he destroyed much of Georgia to force the Confederacy to surrender

5. Robert E. Lee

General in Command of the Confederate Army during the Civil War

6. Thomas “Stonewall” Jackson

Second in command of the Confederate Army during the Civil War

Accidentally killed by his own soldiers at the Battle of Chancellorsville

7. Fort Sumter

The first battle of the Civil War

Confederates opened fire on the Union fort in Charleston Harbor.

8. Battle of Antietam

Bloodiest single day of the Civil War

Ended in a tie. (Memore tip: An"tie"tam)

Stopped the first Confederate invasion of Union territory

9. Battle of Gettysburg

3 day battle

Union victory

Last Confederate invasion of the Union was defeated

10. Battle of Vicksburg

Grant and the Union Army surrounded and captured the city of Vicksburg.

Took control of the Mississippi River, and cut the Confederacy in half (Arkansas, Louisiana, and Texas were cut off)

11. Battle for Atlanta

The Union Army took control of Atlanta

This shut down the transportation (road and railroad) system in the Confederacy, because Atlanta was a transportation hub (all road went through Atlanta).
